

## AVI20 - Miniature Worlds



We will be making miniature scenes using upcycled materials to explore worldbuilding, self-expression, and sustainability in art.

### Stage 1:

1. Take a look at all the upcycled materials in “The Junk Bin.”
2. Take an object from “The Junk Bin,” and turn it into something else, for example, turn the chain into an anchor, turn the gear into a table, etc.
  - a. Add material to it, paint it, change it somehow to be something new












### Stage 2:

1. Choose a **PROMPT** from the following.
2. **Draw a sketch** of what your diorama will look like, including what materials you will use:

Your house/room (either real or ideal)	An original imagined world, or somewhere you'd like to go	Inside your mind	A set for a “deleted scene” from your favourite movie/ TV show
			

### Stage 3:

1. Select a box to build your diorama in, and use various upcycled materials to construct your miniature diorama. Think about the size and dimensions you want.
